At the end of the service, please stay in your seat until an usher indicates that it is your turn to exit. In order to maintain the strict 6' social distancing and protocols required for reopening, only one person/family will exit the Sanctuary through the office hallway and daycare door to return to your vehicles. You must wait your turn to leave.

Please, wear your mask during the entire worship service and until you have returned to your vehicle.

We will not be singing during the service, but humming or speaking the words to the songs is fine.

If you want to attend the in-person service, you must to complete the Health Acknowledgement Form every week by Thursday prior to the service.
